**RE:** **Calallen ISD – Curbside Meal Pick-Up Schedule and Information**

Beginning Wednesday, August 19, 2020, curbside meals will be available for pick-up. We will offer healthy meals for every school day, regardless of face-to-face or virtual instruction selection, to all students that are enrolled with Calallen ISD for the 2020-2021 school year.

**Days:** **Mondays, Wednesday, and Fridays only**  
*Monday pick-up: 2 breakfast & 2 lunch meals*  
*Wednesday pick-up: 2 breakfast & 2 lunch meals*  
*Friday pick-up: 1 breakfast & 1 lunch meal*

**Time:** **11:00 AM to 12:30 PM**

**Locations:** **East Elementary, Magee Elementary, and Wood River Elementary Schools**

**THIS PROGRAM IS OFFERED ONLY TO CURRENTLY ENROLLED CALALLEN ISD STUDENTS.** In order to be given a meal, the student, parent, or guardian **must provide documentation showing a student ID number** (parents can access a student’s ID number when logged into Skyward Family Access, on a student’s report card, or on a student’s ID card). The student is not required to be in the vehicle with the parent or guardian for meal pick-up, so long as proper documentation is provided with the student ID number. However, even if the student is in the car, you must still provide documentation of the student ID number.

**Meal service will include breakfast and lunch.** Breakfast is free for all currently enrolled students for the 2020-2021 school year. The student’s lunch account will be charged based on eligibility, approved 2020-2021 meal prices seen below. In the interest of the health and safety of our staff, students, and parents participating in the curbside meal program, pre-loading your student’s account through the district’s Lunch Money Now payments portal, or providing a check at the curbside pick-up location, are the preferred means of payment. Cash will be accepted, but is discouraged for health and safety reasons.

Households can complete this application at any time throughout the school year as financial situations change.
