According to the commitment provided for your student, they will be continuing with virtual instruction. After the first six weeks, parents/guardians may elect to change the mode of instruction every three weeks, as long as two weeks advanced notice is provided to the campus. Please see the [2020-2021 Instructional Format Calendar](#) for the weeks when you will be able to request a change in instructional format. A form will be available in [Skyward Family Access](#) for you to request the change.

Virtual School Parental Agreement:

Parents/guardians of students receiving virtual instruction must complete the Calallen Virtual School Parent Agreement which outlines parent commitments to ensuring student success in the virtual learning environment. Food Service:

Following the USDA announcement on August 31, 2020, all Calallen ISD students will have access to free meals. Students will be eligible for *free* breakfast and lunch through December 31, 2020. Menus are posted on the [Calallen ISD Food Service](#) website.

Curbside meal pick-up will continue for those students who have selected to stay virtual. Beginning Wednesday, September 9, 2020, curbside meals will be available for pick-up at Magee Elementary only. See below for a full schedule:

Days: Mondays, Wednesday, and Fridays only
Monday pick-up: 2 breakfast & 2 lunch meals
Wednesday pick-up: 2 breakfast & 2 lunch meals
Friday pick-up: 1 breakfast & 1 lunch meal

Visitors to Calallen ISD facilities will be limited to only essential functions of the school. School buildings will remain locked for health and safety reasons. If you need to visit the campus for an emergency, please call the campus to be granted access. Visitor screening protocols will be in place, including required face coverings, sanitizing, temperature checks, and health screening form.
