



## **Calallen ISD Student Tablet Policy**

Calallen ISD student tablets are assigned to students to create a 1:1 computing environment. A 1:1 computing environment encourages creativity and innovation, facilitates communication and collaboration, supports research and access to digital content, increases critical thinking and problem solving opportunities, and promotes the proper use of information and technology.

Campus administrators will select the students who will be assigned a student tablet.

The selected student will be required to check-out the tablet from the campus through the campus library equipment inventory program. Prior to be given custody of the tablet, the student must read, sign, and return the Student Tablet Agreement form to the campus office. The student's parents/guardian must read, sign, and return the Parent/Guardian Agreement form to the campus office. Students and parents must attend a mandatory tablet training session.

The student will be responsible for safety and care of the tablet. The student is required to pay a tablet insurance fee of \$50. This is a yearly fee which covers the tablet in the case of accidental damage. Paying this fee also allows the student to take the tablet home to complete homework assignments and projects.

If a student chooses not to pay the \$50 fee, they will only be allowed to use the tablet during classroom instruction time **AND WILL BE SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY AND ALL DAMAGE AND REPAIR COSTS TO THE TABLET.** The approximate replacement cost for the student tablet is \$350.

Prior to the end of the school year, at a time designated by the campus administrators, the student will be required to return the tablet to the campus and check it in through the campus library equipment inventory program. Campus administrators will be responsible for ensuring all student tablets are returned to the campus.
