

Classroom Policies

1. Every class will begin in the classroom. Announcements will be made at the beginning of class.
2. Each student must be in the classroom **AT THE TARDY BELL.**
3. No horseplay will be allowed in the classroom or shop.
4. No swearing or loud talking will be allowed in the classroom or shop.
5. Students will conduct themselves as responsible young adults.
6. **NO HATS** are to be worn in the Ag. Building or shop, with the exception of welding caps when used in connection with a shop class.
7. **NO TOBACCO IN ANY FORM SHALL BE ALLOWED IN THE CLASSROOM, SHOP, PROJECT CENTER, OR ON FIELD TRIPS!!!**
8. No one is allowed to lean back in their chair or sit on the classroom or shop tables.
9. Students will remain out of the Ag. Office at all times unless they have received permission from a teacher to enter.
10. No student will be allowed to loiter outside of the Ag. Building or in the shop during lunch or before school.
