

## CMS Dress Code 2023-2024

Summarization, refer to the handbook for detailed and more clarification when needed.

All Calallen Middle School students are required to wear the following:

- Any Solid colored "polo" style shirt other than or
- Spirit shirts (T-shirts) may be worn any day of the week. T-shirts that are manufactured from an outside source and are not sponsored through a Calallen organization are allowed and must meet the following requirements: 1. All shirts must have a Calallen logo (Wildcats, Paw Prints, Cats etc.) 2. All shirts must be T-shirt style. (No low-cut shirts, blouses, or shirts with buttons)
- ID Cards must be worn appropriately where their ID is visible every day.

**Pants/Shorts/Capris:** 1. Any solid pants, shorts, and capris may be worn. 2. Fabric may be uniform fabric or denim material jeans. (No holes in pants above the knee showing skin, undergarments or pant inside pockets.) 3. Pants, shorts and capris need to be size appropriate that fit at the waist and the crotch no lower than 2" below the naval. 4. Pants/ shorts/ capris must be hemmed. **Boys**, may not roll them up. 4. Shorts may not be shorter than a dollar bill width from the top of the kneecap. 5. Pants, shorts, and capris must have waistbands with belt loops.

**Not Permitted at School or any School Function:** 1. Slits/tears/holes on body or leg of pants must not show visible skin at any time whether sitting or standing above the knee. 2. Tights or leggings must be worn under pants that have slits/tears/holes above the knee. 3. Frayed pant legs must not show skin above the knee. 4. Low rise pantsmust fit at waist and be worn at waist. 5. Bagging, sagging, oversized will not be permitted. 6. Above the knee leggings, bike shorts are not permitted. 5. **Girls only**, tights leggings/jeggings may not be worn unless the top meets dress code length for the skirts.

**Belts**: **1.** Large belt buckles are not permitted. **2.** Belts and buckles must be school appropriate. **3.** Spikes or inappropriate designs or messages are not allowed. **4.** Belts **may** be worn but must be of appropriate length for student waist size and the belt must be kept in the belt loops.

**Polo Shirts:** 1. Polo shirts must be solid colored other than 2. Shirts may be cotton or dri-fit material. 3. Shirts may be long or short sleeved 4. Shirts must be "polo" type shirts with a collar. No more than 2 top buttons may remain unbuttoned. 5. The length of the shirt cannot hang longer than the finger tips and must hang past the top of the front pocket or to the wrist, if there are no pockets on the pants. 6. All shirts that hang longer than the finger tips must be tucked in. 7. Appropriate undergarments will be worn at all times. 8. Colored or patterned undergarments that are visible through clothing are not permitted. 9. Sleeveless shirts are not permitted. 8. Shirts may not have snaps or zippers. 9. Any torn clothing is not permitted. 10. **Girls only**- See through shirts or blouses/low-necked shirts that show cleavage, tied knotted shirts, mid-riff shirts are not permitted.

**Sweaters/Coats/Windbreakers/ Sweat Jackets: 1.** Logos are permitted. Any logos or labels on outerwear must be school appropriate. **2.** Outerwear must be of appropriate size, not oversized or baggy. **3.** Oversized coats or trench coats are not permitted **4.** Outerwear may not be worn around the waist or hanging off the shoulders or backwards. **5.** Any colored pullover or sweat shirts are allowed. Hoods on jackets or pullovers are not permitted in the building.

stst CMS Administration has the authority to make a ruling on any dress code in question. stst

**Shoes:** 1. Shoes must be worn at all times. Backless shoes or sandals are **NOT** permitted. Shoes, designed to be worn with shoelaces, must be laced and tied appropriately. 2. Steel toed boots are not allowed. 3. No Heelies (shoes with wheels) will be allowed. 4. House shoes are not permitted 5. Stiletto heels are not permitted

*Hair:* 1. Hair must be neat, clean and well-groomed at all times. 2. Completely shaved or partially shaved heads. (Shaved underneath and a long top) are not permitted. 3. Extremely dyed/partially/painted/unnatural hair color, designs, or insignias are not permitted. 4. Hair may not cover the eyes or hang in front of the face. 5. Distracting braids, colored inserts, mohawks, or fauxhawks are not permitted.

**Earrings/Make-up and Body Art: 1.** Stickers or tattoos on the face or body are not permitted. **2.** Cosmetic contact lenses are not permitted. **3.** Writing on the skin is not permitted. **4.** Coloring in of fingernails using markers or any other writing utensil is not permitted. **5.** Body or face piercings are not permitted. **6.** Notching of the eyebrows is not permitted. **7.** Writing on clothes is not permitted. **8.** Absolutely no plugs, bars, gages, tapers, or tunnels are permitted.

Accessories: 1. Accessories may not display weapons, drugs, drug paraphernalia and/or alcohol, sexual or foul language. 2. Hats/caps/bandanas/sunglasses may not be worn in the building. 3. Costumes, or head ware such as cat ears will not be permitted. 4. Chains on pants or wallets are not permitted. 5. No safety pins may be worn on clothing or as jewelry. 6. Sweatbands are permitted in PE or Athletics with Coaches approval. 7. Bracelets are limited to 2 per wrist. 8. No studded or spiked wrist bracelets, necklaces, or accessories. 9. Backpacks/drawstring totes must be small enough to fit underneath a desk or a back of a chair. Students will be limited to one backpack or drawstring tote to carry with them from class to class. All other bags need to be placed in their lockers. Bags must not be on the floor blocking aisles or walk-ways. 10. Accessories that distract from the learning environment will be taken away.

## In addition, Female Students Standardized Dress:

**Earrings/Make-up/Body Art:** 1. A maximum of 2 earrings may be worn on each ear. 2. Black lipstick is not permitted. 4. Body/face glitter is not permitted.

**Skirts/Jumpers:** 1. Skirts/jumpers must be solid colored uniform fabric or denim. 2. Skirts/jumpers must be no shorter than a dollar bill in width from the top of the kneecap. 3. Stretch material or tight-fitting skirts are not permitted. 4. Skirts may not have slits that do not meet the dollar bill width guideline.

## In addition, Male Students Standardized dress:

Earrings/Make-up/Body Art: 1. Earrings are not permitted. 2. Make-up and nail polish are not permitted.

*Hair:* 1. Sides may be no longer than mid-ear. 2. Haircuts using clippers smaller than a 1 are discouraged. 3. Hair cannot pass the top of the collar on a polo-style, collared shirt. 4. Hair restraints, man-buns, and pony tails are not permitted. 5. No facial hair is permitted. 6. Hair may not touch the top of the eyebrows. 7. Hair must be trimmed to the eyebrows so not to cover the eyes. 8. Dreadlocks and braids must meet appropriate dress-code hair length (hair cannot pass the top of the collar on a polo-style, collared shirt.)

Violations for Dress Code: 1. Students not in dress code upon entering the building will be asked to call home to correct the dress code issue. 2. Student who are unable to correct the dress code issue by 10:00 a.m. will be assigned after school detention for the following school day. 3. Students receiving more than four dress code detentions in a nine-week period will be assigned in-school suspension for each subsequent infraction during that nine-week period. 4. Students with dress code violations considered to be inappropriate for the classroom setting will be subject to after school detention, in-school suspension, or other consequences to be determined by the campus administrator.
